

MANZANITA CANYON

With a rich ruby color, rich aromas of juicy cherry and blackberry, and a soft, lush texture, this **2005 Cabernet Sauvignon** is a wine that invites immediate consumption, but will also reward two or three years of cellaring.

The Paso Robles fruit is in the forefront of this blend, lending it's baked cherry, cassis and leather character to the plum jam, super-ripe tobacco-and-spice profile of the Lodi wine. The latter was harvested at 25.5 Brix and macerated for 28 days before pressing. It yielded a darker colored, richer wine with unusually fine chocolate and roasted fruit tones. Added to these were small amounts of refined, yet fruity Lake County wine; and wine from a hillside vineyard in Sonoma County which gave lush elegance. These final two components provide a bit more focus and refinement to the overall blend.

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
