Tasting Notes:

This is a monster Merlot from an excellent vintage – one of our best Handprints ever. A blend of grapes from the Dry Creek, Russian River and Alexander Valleys, this wine has a nose of strawberries and cherries wrapped in French oak, and the cherries roll onto the palate accompanied by strawberry/rhubarb notes and lots of spice. The persistent finish surrounds you like a big brother at his little sister's first dance.
