

### Nicole Chanrion 2005 Cote de Brouilly

Notice that CÔTE-de-Brouilly is singular. That's because there is only one côte, or hill, here, and the "hill of Brouilly" is the south-ernmost grand cru in the Beaujolais.

Nicole's Côte-de-Brouilly represents a sort of gateway to the Rhône.

Indeed, Côte Rôtie is only

about forty minutes

south. And her wine

shows hints of

Rhône-like cinnamon

and spices. Nicole

mentioned the subtlety

of cherry blossoms. This fruitiness is perfectly

balanced by minerality and spices on the finish.



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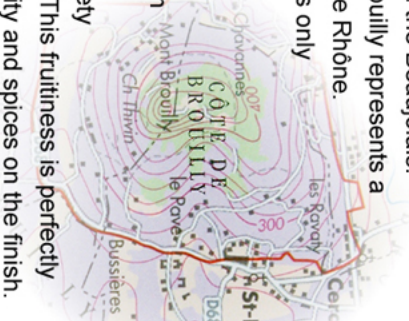
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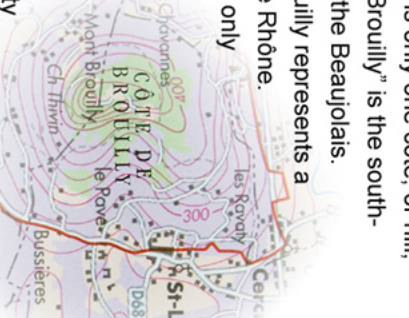
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
